



Future News

Purpose:

To work together as a team, share ideas and think about future objectives and team goals

Time:

1 hour of planning (suggested) and 15 minutes presentation, plus approx. 30 minutes for discussion (optional).

Instructions:

Part 1: In your team, you should discuss the following:

- Where are we now? What headlines would you identify that represent the current contribution of the team?
- Where do we want to be in 12 months time and what headlines do we want to be making?

Once you have discussed this, please think of a name for your newspaper and produce two front pages– one reflecting the present and one reflecting your future headlines. Your front page should have a summary of your main story and as many sub stories as you can fit onto the page.

You will be asked to present back your front pages to the rest of the group and you may do so in any style you think appropriate

Delegates can present using flipchart or by creating something on PowerPoint or other package.

(You may even give them a specific newspaper to create headlines and stories for to encourage different ways of thinking)

Part 2 (Optional): Allow delegates to quiz each other about the story BEHIND the headline – what led to that? What was the impact? How did we get from A to B Etc.
